Would an EPacket work well for your company?

A few years ago, UWBH started offering an electronic version of our full packets, to save on costs and be a more user-friendly version of sharing our mission within workplaces. It's been a hit, and more and more companies are choosing this option.

How it works:

You will receive an email from our Development Director, Mari Sheldon, shortly after our campaign begins, this year on July 15th. The email will have several attachments so you can pick and choose what to share with your employees, as YOU know them best. All individual documents in your Epacket can be found at:

You will also find forms and documents here such as our Annual Report, impact stories, pledge forms, and more!

In addition, we have provided workplace communication templates such as email templates and social media planning to interact within your workplace virtually. You may view these options on the website as indicated above.

- Employees fill out their pledge form either electronically or they can print it and fill it in
- Completed pledge forms are then emailed, or printed copies are turned into your HR department or person handling your internal campaign
- Once he/she feels that your workplace campaign is complete, these forms need to be turned into your payroll department for processing
- The printed versions or electronic copies of the pledge forms must be returned to us along with a completed Employee Summary Report, which calculates your company's total
